- If a candidate is booked under malpractice, he/she is not eligible to apply for revaluation of any courses registered. Further their placement opportunities may get affected.
- If a candidate is in final year or from passed out batches requesting in the answer booklet to pass the examination, then all the courses he/she had taken up will be scrutinized. If it is repeated, then the courses registered are all invalidated.
- If a candidate had only arrear examinations and indulged in malpractice, then all the courses registered are invalidated.
