Minutes of 18th Board of Studies Meeting DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL ENGINEERING

The 18th Board of Studies meeting of the Department of Civil Engineering, Sona College of Technology (Autonomous), Salem held on 03-06-2021 at 09.30 a.m. online using the Microsoft team app.

Dr.R. Malathy, Chairman of the Board of Studies, Department of Civil Engineering, Sona College of Technology, initiated the meeting with a warm welcome to all the members present and all the members introduced themselves.

The following items were discussed and the corresponding resolutions were adopted:

- Discussion of Vision, Mission, Programme Educational Objectives, Programme Outcomes, and Programme Specific Outcomes
- Discussion of the curriculum for Under Graduate course B.E.- Civil Engineering from semester III to VII for Regulation 2019
- Approval of the curriculum:
 - Under Graduate course B.E.- Civil Engineering from semester III to VII for Regulation 2019
- 4. Approval of a syllabus:

- Under Graduate course B.E.- Civil Engineering of semester V for Regulation 2019
- Discussion and approval of including NPTEL courses as an elective course in the fifth semester for B.E.-Civil Engineering for Reg 2019 which was approved by the Department Consultative committee.
- Discussion and approval of one-credit courses for B.E.-Civil Engineering which approved by the Department Consultative committee

During the deliberations of the 18thBoard of Studies meeting, the members recommended the following points for improving the Curriculum.

- Overall view of the Department of Civil Engineering in the form of Student Achievements, Awards
 received and MoU's signed for the AY 20-21 was given by the Head of the Department, Dr.R.Malathy.
- Highlights of the 18th BOS meeting such as the inclusion of advanced technologies such as 3D Printing, AR, VR, etc., Discussing the 5th Semester curriculum & syllabi, NPTEL and 1credit course were stated by Mr.P.Ashokkumar, Assistant Professor/Civil Engineering Department
- In the Structural Analysis subject, no reduction in topics was approved by the Expert Committee.
 Instead, relaxation towards change in Question paper pattern was allowed due to the current pandemic situation.
- In the Soil Mechanics syllabus, the title of Unit 3 (Vertical Stress Distribution) was changed. Also, the addition of standard reference books was suggested by the expert.
- 5. As the DRC syllabus concerned, corrections such as the inclusion of introduction to Working Stress Method, analysis of crack width(theory only), changing the unit -3 title to design of slab and staircase, in-unit -5 topics such as Isolated Pad & Rectangular footing, concepts of combined footing(theory only).
- In Laboratory courses such as CAD drawing, experts suggested including topics useful while undergoing building approval; in the soil mechanics laboratory syllabus few topics were modified and no modifications in the Survey Camp syllabus.
- 7. Experts suggested offering Remote sensing subjects for other branches such as IT, CSE, etc. Maximum number of Textbooks to be limited to 2 and proper format of textbook/reference to be followed while framing syllabus for all the subjects.
- For Housing Planning and Management, experts told to include TamilNadu Combined Development rules(recent version) along with Nation Building Code(NBC) in references.
- In Architecture and Town Planning, instead of Building Byelaws specific topics only to be included; also
 in Construction practices, topics such as step-by-step procedure in Piling was suggested
- 10. For Municipal Solid Waste Management, the inclusion of the following topics were suggested by the expert committee: Construction and Demolition Waste Rules, Gas Collection System, Landfill capping, and Landfill Mining
- 11. Air Pollution specific act to be included in Air Pollution Management syllabus. Textbooks to be verified.

- 12. When proper Indian author books not available, foreign author books are taken as Textbooks otherwise preference should be given to Indian authors.
- 13. Only two textbooks for each course and the remaining can be moved to reference books. This will enable the students to refer and buy the books in easy mode.
- 14. The list of electives provided every semester for the students shall be given a roadmap so that the students can take up courses to develop a specific skill for industry requirements thus provide them with placement opportunities.
- 15. According to the streams, the electives shall be redistributed so that the students can decide as per their learning internet.

As there was no other item introduced by any member for discussion, the Chairman, BoS, adjourned the meeting. Thanked the members for their participation and valuable suggestions and concluded the meeting.
