Dr. S.R.R. Senthil Kumar, Principal, welcomed the Governing Body members and the faculty and the staff of Sona College of Technology and presented the details of the achievements of the institution to the members for comments, discussion, and approval.

A. GENERAL:

Item No.A1

To confirm and approve the minutes of the previous Governing Body Meeting held on 23.12.2021 and approve the actions taken on the minutes

- The GB meeting started at 10:20 am Mr. C. Valliappa, Chairman, The Sona Group, presided over the meeting.
- Dr. S. R. R. Senthil Kumar, Principal, welcomed the Governing Body members and the faculty and the staff of Sona College of Technology. He extended a special thanks to Dr. Sandhya Chintala for accepting our invitation to be a member of Governing Body & Advisory Board. He congratulated Dr.VimalRarh and Dr. Shoba Raj Kumar for their promotions as Professors.
- Chairman, Mr. C. Valliappa welcomed the GB members. In his opening remarks, he
 mentioned that that was the first GB meeting in the tallest building in Salem. Both
 the Vice-Chairmen, Mr. Chocko Valliappa and Mr. Thyagu Valliappa suggested that
 the new building, the 8 storeyed building be named 'Valliappa Block' and father
 Xavier Alphonse, seconded the suggestion and it was accepted and appreciated by all
 the members. The Chairman accepted the honour with a smile.
- The Chairman congratulated Sona team for commendable achievements in both admissions and placements.
- The members confirmed the minutes of the previous Governing Body meeting held on 02.07.2021 and approved the action and follow up of the minutes. The Principal made a power point presentation which was a consolidation of the activities and achievements of the college during the last six months.

B. ADMINISTRATION:

- The Chairman expressed his concern about the delay in the commencement of classes for PG programmes. Chairman also added that the application for emerging courses must be considered and approved by Anna University.
- The Principal explained that the Anna University is waiting for the court order to start the PG counselling. Dr.Vimal Rarh asked the Principal to follow up with the authorities concerned to sort out the issues related to PG counselling and also mentioned that she could extend her support whenever possible.

C. ACHIEVEMENTS

To peruse the State Level, National Level and International Level awards and honours received by the institution, departments and faculty members

- The Principal was joined by the Vice-Chairmen and GB members in appreciating the faculty for the top ranking performance in NPTEL.
- The Principal and the GB members extended their appreciations to Vice Chairman,
 Mr. Chocko Valliappa, for authoring 2 chapters in the book titled 'Smart Villages' published by Springer.
- The Principal presented the ATAL award attained by Sona Vice-Chairman, Mr. Thyagu Valliappa, suggested video must be made on such special achievements and must be posted on You Tube.
- The honour bestowed on Sona alumnus, Mr. Prithiviraj Chauhan, by our Tamilnadu Chief Minister Mr. M.K. Stalin was presented and the same was recorded.
- The internshala team headed by Dr.Sivagami was congratulated for obtaining 15th rank in Tamilnadu. The ranking was bestowed by AICTE.
- The Principal presented the COVID relief measures carried out by Sona and expressed his gratitude to the Management members for their contributions to the society during the pandemic. Dr.Veerappan and other GB members jointly appreciated Sona for the timely contributions to the society.

- Vice Chairman, Mr. Chocko Valliappa mentioned that an app has been developed to prevent COVID infection taking all guidelines of ACMR.
- The GB members placed on record their special appreciations to Vice-Chairman, Mr.

- The GB members appreciated Dr. R. Malathy and Dr.Gulshan Taj for getting certified as IGBC Accredited Professionals in Green Buildings and Construction Building standards and codes.
- The GB members congratulated the team for the ranks conferred on Sona by top ranking magazines like Outlook, The Week, The Times.
- MrParasuraman congratulated the Sona team for its wonderful achievements in several areas. He expressed his opinion that an elaborate roadmap must be developed for taking the institution to the next level. He insisted that thorough benchmark for KPI, Pedagogy, feedback and placements (Ave: 12 LPA) must be fixed.
- He extended a special appreciation for Sona's achievements in the niche areas like wearable and augmented technologies by signing a MoU with UHN for fiber and related technologies research and with IIT for incubation and startup respectively.

The Principal presented the new courses to be introduced and the details of the increase and decrease in intake during 2022 – 2023.

- ➤ B. Tech Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (Proposed intake for 2022-2023: 60)
- M. Tech Apparel Technology (Proposed intake for 2022-2023: 12)

➤ B. Tech Artificial Intelligence and Data Science (increase in intake 2022-2023: 60 to 120)

❖ Decrease in Intake

➤ B.E. Mechanical Engineering (decrease in intake 2022- 2023: 150 to 120)

The same was approved by the GB members.

- Mr.Thyagu Valliappa mentioned that the perspective plan for 2022 must include energy conservation as the prime aspect and in perspective plan 2023 the focus must be on attaining deemed university status, obtaining 5 patents per year and to apply for ABET Accreditation.
- Father Xavier Alphonse suggested concentrating on becoming "An Institute of
 Excellence (IoE)"which will be an alternative to Deemed to be University status. He
 further added that the institute must prepare a ten page write-up including the
 history and achievements of Sona, roadmap for five years and the outcome of
 becoming an Institution of Excellence.
- Father Xavier Alphonse expressed his opinion that Sona, including Arts and Medical colleges, must compete with Sona and establish a paradigm shift by drawing a roadmap for the next 3 years starting from 2022. He also mentioned that BCIC can be an industry partner for Sona's move towards IoE.

- Father also added that the GB members can move a resolution to form a task force to apply for IoE. Dr. Veerappan and both the Vice Chairmen along with the Principal endorsed the view expressed by Father.
- MrChocko Valliappa insisted that this proposal must be taken up immediately and the Principal asked for inputs from the GB members. Dr. Veerappan immediately responded that he would be part of the task force representing the industry.
- MrThyagu Valliappa added that a background paper must be developed at the earliest and also insisted on bringing in alumni strength.

F. ADMISSIONS

Item No. F1

To Peruse and approve the student admission status

- The Chairman mentioned that the Tamilnadu Governor was an NCC cadet. He also stated that like other states, Tamilnadu must also announce some reservations for NCC cadet in the admission.
- The Principal appreciated the Admission Team for admitting quality students for the academic year 2021-2022. He mentioned that the admission has been very good this year with 98% in the first year B.E/B.Tech, 100% in MBA & MCA programmes and 96% in Lateral Entry.
- The Principal thanked the Management for giving one crore worth scholarship for students who qualified Sona EEE.

G. INFRASTRUCTURE

To peruse and approve the infrastructure development

- Mr.Thyagu Valliappa requested the industry members to provide SonaLIKE with different industry profile catalogues for the benefit of students.
- Mr.Thyagu Valliappa suggested setting up industry coffee shop near library. The idea
 is to extend Sona's hospitality to industrial friends. When they pass by Sona, they
 can stop at Sona and have a cup of coffee and visit the landmark library.
- The Principal informed the members that the University block has been occupied by the respective departments.
- The block has proved to be one of the blessed blocks in terms of successful admissions, placements, awards and accolades that the institution received.

Mr.Thyagu Valliappa mentioned that the MBA students were provided with i-pads. He
also stated that the campus has already moved from more paper to less paper and
will in future move to no paper.

H. FACULTY/STAFF

To peruse and approve the faculty norms, recruitment, etc.

- Dr. Veerappan stressed on taking feedback from faculty. He further added that a
 third person must be appointed to interact with the faculty to understand their
 feeling level to measure the happiness index. This was seconded by Father Xavier
 Alphonse.
- MrChocko Valliappa added that cultural audit must also be carried out.

I. REVIEW OF AUTONOMOUS STATUS

Item No.I1 to I2

To peruse and review the autonomous status and accreditation status

The Principal acknowledged the GB members and Father Xavier for their suggestions to offer Advanced Diploma Courses. He also presented the list of courses, curriculum and syllabi which were reviewed and approved by the GB members.

J. COLLABORATION INITIATIVES WITH INDUSTRY

Item No.J1

To peruse and approve the collaboration initiatives with industry

- The Principal mentioned that Sona has signed an MoU with IITM to support start-ups with mentorship and to facilitate the flow of funds / grants. He also added that out of the four projects that were presented, 2 were selected for development. Vice-chairman, Mr. Chocko Valliappa reiterated the fact that the IIT has accepted to incubate Sona's projects.
- Mr. Thyagu Valliappa stated that the BCIC has agreed to establish its extended centre at Sona to provide the students with hands-on experience. Mr. Parasuram, President BCIC, assured to inaugurate the centre by January 2022.
- The Principal elaborated on the seven MoUs signed by Sona with different organisations

- MrThyagu Valliappa emphasised that education must be more powerful than industry only then it can become aligned with industrial advancements and nurture industry readiness among the students.
- The Principal presented the details of MoU signed with CapGemini for Embedded System and VLSI. He also stated that this facility will be extended to Mechanical, Mechatronics and Biomedical Engineering departments.
- Vice-Chairman, Mr. Thyagu Valliappa, insisted on extending services in skill matrix to graduates and give appraisal enabling them to building the required skills and apply for jobs appropriately. He also mentioned that Sona can become a centre for skill assessment.
- MrThyagu Valliappa added that Sona Star would give the industry support required to Sona students
- Dr. Sanjeevi also suggested that study and work culture must be nurtured among students.
- Mr. Parasuram suggested launching an exchange programme with Toyota. This facility will enable Sona faculty to get trained in the industry-oriented skills. He emphasized that all the above initiatives will go a long way improving the brand value of Sona.

K. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

Item No.K1 to K3 To peruse and review progress in R&D work

- The Principal presented the patent highlights. During the last six months, 10 patents have been published and two patents have been filed.
- Sona's research collaborations with Fiber Network which is based in Canada received due appreciations from the GB members. The Principal explained the scope of extensive research work in future.
- To promote the research works, it has been decided to introduce Research Fellowship with stipend up to Rs. 20,000/- for full time Ph.D scholars.
- Mr. Rudhra Shankar Roy mentioned that Sona faculty members can become IBM Fellow Researchers.
- Dr.Veerappan mentioned that most of the faculty exchange programmes and industry institute interaction programmes can be conducted online and Sona can function as satellite office for these programmes. This, he said that, will turn out to be a win-win model.

- The Principal mentioned that Ixceed and Tessolve have already established their centre on Sona campus.
- The members appreciated that the portal which has been developed exclusively for R&D has come out well.
- Dr. Veerappan highlighted the need for introducing industry support division.
- MrChocko Valliappa insisted on revisiting all the MoUs and said that the same must be updated in the R&D portal.
- Both the Vice Chairmen emphasized on increasing the number of publications and participation in International conferences. They also insisted on conducting at least one International Conference per year by the departments in rotation.

L. ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CELL

To peruse the activities of Entrepreneurship Development Cell

- Mr. Thyagu Valliappa explained the functioning of 'Power On Me', the ideation camp, which will also foster rural entrepreneurship development.
- Two teams which have been selected and supported by Sona Management won the 1st and 2nd place in the TNSI 2020 competition and received a cash award of Rs.1lakh.
