In the meeting the following points were discussed.

1. The members of the anti ragging committee were briefed regarding the faculty interaction with hostel inmates and the surprise visits during lunch hours, break timings in morning and evening in the classrooms, corridors of first year class rooms and in cafeteria to know about any untold incidents in the respective regions.
2. It was briefed to the members regarding the awareness being created inside the campus and hostel regarding ragging, its punishments and helpline for freshers was displayed during the Induction programme which was conducted on 18/08/2018.
3. The deployment of one security person during night hours to monitor student's safety exclusively as one of the anti ragging measures taken by institution has been explained to the members of the committee.

4. The Security Officer was instructed that his security guards should monitor the students movement inside the campus and inform to the Principal about any act of ragging if taking place.
5. All the faculties, Residential Tutors and other hostel authorities were requested to ensure that there are no unwanted incidents related to ragging happening inside the hostel and safe guard all the first year students.
6. The Principal and Chairman of Anti Ragging Committee appreciated that so far no ragging has taken place inside the premises in the past and requested all the members of the committee to ensure that it continues in this year also.
7. The first year male and female students residing hostels told that there is no ragging inside the campus and hostel and also they felt comfortable in the campus.
8. One of the members of the anti-ragging committee, Mr. P. Sahasranamam requested the principal to insist the reading habit and effective utilization of library facilities inside and outside campus. The Principal and the first year HOD informed to the members that there is one hour is allotted to the first year students to utilize the college central library facilities, so that more knowledge can be gained by the students instead of thinking these types of unwanted activities.
9. Also the members were briefed about the students speaker's forum is also used by the students irrespective of their branches and year of study is very useful to mingle among them. First year students are also making use of this forum and they are guided by the faculty members and senior students.
10. The Principal assured that the suggestions given by the members Mr. Sahasranamam will be implemented through various events conducted by Sona for the benefit of students.
11. Finally, the members appreciated the efforts taken by the institution in curbing the menace of ragging.

The meeting came to end by 6.00 pm.
