

REPORT (2015-2016)

RESURVEY

On June 19, 20, 22 and July 4,5, 2015, Our NSS volunteers visited villages Kandarkulamanickam and Aandipatti and conducted detailed survey in collaboration with Centre for Social Responsibility Initiatives(CSRI). About 50 volunteers participated in this survey. Volunteers started surveying by 2:30p.m. Volunteers collected details about family members, sanitary facilities, employment details, farmland usage, reach of government facilities and such other 50 details. About 250 houses were surveyed by volunteers. The details were submitted to CSRI. Our volunteers returned to college by 5:30p.m.



ORPHANAGE VISIT-I

On 11th July 2015, Our Sona NSS wing organized an orphanage visit to **Anbu Illam, Thalavaipatti and Thai Anbu Illam, Yercaud adivaram**. 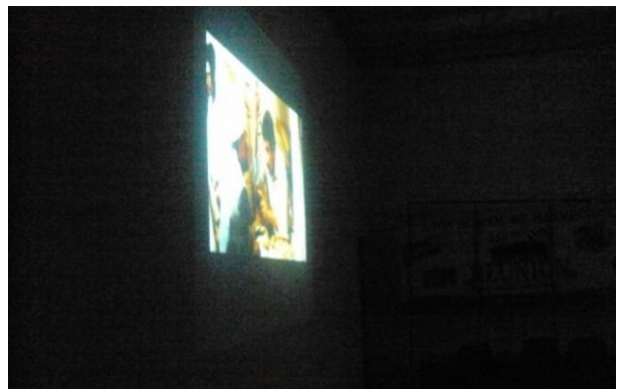
INDEPENDENCE DAY

Our NSS volunteers collected amount of Rs.5500 and other basic need materials. 11 NSS volunteers along with college management reached Cuddalore on 9th December 2015 by 8 a.m. We distributed materials like **Blankets, Breads, Rice, Red gram, Dhal, Sugar, Sambhar Powder, Sarees, Lungi, Towels, Napkins, Oil, Cooking Utensils, Mud blisters, Medicines** for areas – Bharathi Nagar-B Block, Naiyanaar Kuppam, Kalkulam on Day 1 and Manchakuppam on Day 2. After distributing the relief materials our volunteers returned to college on 11th December 2015.

From 17th February 2016, the special camp was organized by our NSS Wing of Sona College of Technology, Salem. We adopted 2 villages **Kandarkulamanickam and Aandipatti**. The camp was held in order to promote awareness among the people and to uplift them self by self employment, the way to benefit in their own agricultural lands, their medical health and also provided latest medical facilities available.

DAY 1:

On the first day of the camp, volunteers reached the campsite by 10.00am. Volunteers started interacting with the people by 10.45 a.m. in both the villages (Kandarkulamanickam and Aandipatti). **Volunteers distributed pamphlets** and explained about the various events that were about to be conducted during seven days of the camp to the village people and asked about their various needs. The session ended by 4.30 pm and the volunteers reached college by 6 pm.



DAY 2:

On the second day of the camp, the volunteers reached the campsite by 10.00 am. The volunteers involved in “**SWACHH BHARAT**”. Volunteers cleaned 8 spots (post office, around Kandarkulamanickam School, playground, Aandipatti, Ariyampalayam, veterinary hospital, mariyamman kovil, VAO office) of the villages and **TREE SAPLINGS** were planted in and around the Kandarkulamanickam village and saplings were also given to the people who requested for it during the survey. The volunteers reached the college by 6 pm.



DAY 3:

On the third day of our camp, the volunteers reached the campsite by 9.30am. **“EYE CAMP”** was conducted by **Aravind Eye Hospital**, Salem in Kandarkulamanickam village. About 105 people were benefitted by the eye camp. Simultaneously, **“First Aid demonstration”** was given in Aandipatti primary school by VIMS hospital to villagers. The volunteers reached the college by 6 pm.



DAY 4:

On the fourth day, the volunteers reached the campsite by 9.30am. London Ortho Hospital conducted **“ORTHO CAMP”** in Aandipatti. Meanwhile, Library recreation and gardening was conducted in Kandarkulamanickam. In gardening **50 trees was planted in Kandarkulamanickam School premises** and Library recreation was done with 82 books. **“One day farmer”** was held through which 24 of our volunteers learnt about farming pattern. Meanwhile, 52 volunteers visited Sona Valliapa Textile Mill private limited and learnt about fabrication of cotton, stitching process of shirt and various stages of yarn production. The volunteers reached the college by 6.30pm.



DAY 5:

On the fifth day of the camp, the volunteers reached the college by 8.30 am. **“GENERAL CAMP”** was conducted by Sri Gokulam Hospital, Salem in **Kandarkulamanickam**. Around 210 people of Kandarkulamanickam and Aandipatti villages were benefited by the camp. Simultaneously, **awareness seminar on “Open Defecation System”** was conducted in Kandarkulamanickam. Meanwhile, fun events were conducted in 3 main places of Kandarkulamanickam. The villagers actively participated in fun events. The events ended by 4:30 pm and the volunteers returned to college by 5:30 pm.



DAY 6:

On the sixth day, the volunteers reached the campsite by 8.30am. **“Ortho Camp”** was conducted by **London Ortho Hospital, Salem in Kandarkulamanickam**. Around 70 people in and around Kandarkulamanickam were benefited by this camp. Simultaneously in Aandipatti, **“Yoga Demonstration”** was conducted by Dr.Malathi from Blue lotus nature cure hospital in Aandipatti primary school to school children. An interactive session was conducted between NSS programme officer and volunteers for improving our volunteer’s soft skills and career development skills. The volunteers reached the college by 6.30pm.’



DAY 7:

On the seventh day, the volunteers reached the campsite by 9.00 am. Our volunteers were engaged in conducting events like **essay writing, storytelling, quiz, missing letters, mathematical calculations, drawing, speech** for school students in both the villages and **general knowledge charts** were also displayed.
