The chairman of the committee and the Principal, Dr. S.R.R. Senthilkumar has presided over the meeting.

The following points were discussed.

1. The members of the anti-ragging committee were briefed regarding the precautionary steps taken against ragging and regular monitoring of students in the campus and hostels by the members and squads. The Principal informed to the students that Dr. D. Senthilkumar, HOD/Mechanical department was deputed as Dean-Student Affairs and he will taking care of student's welfare.
2. The member secretary informed that an awareness programme regarding ragging was conducted to all the first year students on 05.08.2019 as one of the events in a AICTE mandatory induction programme.
3. Also informed that there is a faculty interaction with the inmates of the hostel has been arranged in the beginning of the year for four months to make the students to feel a homely environment.

4. Surprise visits by the squads and faculty members during lunch hours, break timings in morning and evening in the classrooms, corridors of first year classrooms and in cafeteria to know about any untold incidents in the respective regions.
5. The deployment of one security person during night hours to monitor student's safety exclusively as one of the anti ragging measures taken by institution has been explained to the members of the committee.
6. The Security Officer was instructed that his security guards should monitor the student's movement inside the campus and inform to the Principal about any act of ragging if taking place.
7. All the faculties, Residential Tutors and other hostel authorities were requested to ensure that there are no unwanted incidents related to ragging happening inside the hostel and safe guard all the first year students.
8. The member secretary of Anti Ragging Committee appreciated that so far no ragging has taken place inside the premises in the past and requested all the members of the committee to ensure that it continues in this semester also.
9. The first year male and female students residing hostels told that there is no ragging inside the campus and hostel and also they felt comfortable in the campus.
10. The members were briefed about the students speaker's forum is used by the students irrespective of their branches and year of study is very useful to mingle among them. First year students are also making use of this forum and they are guided by the faculty members and senior students.
11. The warden, Mr. TVK. Lakshminarasimhan told that he and his team are regularly monitoring the first year and senior students activities especially in the study hours in the night time.
12. The member secretary informed that there is no complaint phone call and email received from the students regarding ragging.
13. Finally, the members appreciated the efforts taken by the institution in curbing the menace of ragging.

The meeting came to end by 6.00 pm.
