16.12.2021

The first meeting of the anti-ragging committee for the academic year 2021 – 2022 was conducted on 15.12.2021 @ 4.45 pm in the Mechanical conference hall. The following members were present:

Dr. M. Renuga, HOD / English presided over the meeting.

The following points were discussed.

1. The member secretary, Dr. T. Maruthavanan welcomed the gathering and introduced the faculty members and warden, associate wardens of hostels to the first year students. He briefed about the precautionary steps taken against ragging and regular monitoring of students in the campus and hostels by the members and squads.
2. Dr. M. Renuga, HOD/English department insisted the members to ensure the safety of first year students both in campus and hostels.
3. The member secretary informed that an awareness programme regarding ragging was conducted to all the first year students on 27.10.2021 as one of the events in an AICTE mandatory Students Induction Programme. This year the programme was conducted through online due to pandemic situation.
4. Also informed that there is a faculty interaction with the inmates of the hostel has been arranged in the beginning of the year to make the students to feel a homely environment.
5. Surprise visits by the squads and faculty members during lunch hours, break timings in morning and evening in the classrooms, corridors of first year class

rooms and in cafeteria to know about any untold incidents in the respective regions.

6. The deployment of one security person during night hours to monitor student's safety exclusively as one of the anti ragging measures taken by institution has been explained to the members of the committee.
7. The Security personal was instructed that his security guards should monitor the student's movement inside the campus and inform to the Principal about any act of ragging if taking place.
8. All the faculties, Residential Tutors and other hostel authorities were requested to ensure that there are no unwanted incidents related to ragging happening inside the hostel and safe guard all the first year students.
9. The member secretary of Anti Ragging Committee appreciated that so far no ragging has taken place inside the premises in the past and requested all the members of the committee to ensure that it continues in this year also.
10. The first year male and female students residing hostels and dayscholars told that there is no ragging inside the campus and hostel and also they felt comfortable in the campus.
11. The members were briefed about the students speaker's forum is used by the students irrespective of their branches and year of study is very useful to mingle among them. First year students are also making use of this forum and they are guided by the faculty members and senior students.
12. The warden, Mr. TVK. Lakshminarasimhan told that he and his team are regularly monitoring the first year and senior students activities especially in the study hours in the night time.
13. The member secretary informed that there is no complaint phone call and email received from the students regarding ragging.
14. Finally, the members appreciated the efforts taken by the institution in curbing the menace of ragging.

The meeting came to end by 5.30 pm.
